


Keith Spencer

Keith regularly appears as a guest artist with many professional artistic organizations including the Capital Philharmonic of New Jersey. In their last collaboration, Mr. Spencer performed his tour-de-force one-person concert experience, *Brothers on Broadway – A Celebration of Broadway's African-American Leading Men* to rave reviews and record-breaking audiences at the Patriots Theater at the War Memorial in Trenton, NJ.
